In “Nassau University Medical Center Notifies New York State On Its Intentions To Sue For \$1.06 Billion” (Long Island Herald, November 19, 2024), the Long Island Herald reports on a \$1.06 billion Notice of Claim filed with Attorney General Letitia James by Nassau University Medical Center against New York State. The claim accuses the state of “orchestrating a ruse to mislead the federal government” and illegally withholding funds owed to the hospital as part of the federal Disproportionate Share Hospital program.
